## Monday June 9th



### Art is **AWESOME** *For ages PreK - 5 years*

On this day, these little artists will be introduced to the world of art, from learning about famous art and artists, to creating their own piece of art to take home and proudly display!



### **THE GREAT ART HEIST LOCKBOX CHALLENGE** *For ages 6 yrs - 6th grade*

The famous HAKA Dance is back...but this time, IT'S WAR! Under the guidance of Brian Sibert and Joe Eckert, the kids will not only learn this ceremonial Māori dance of New Zealand, but will then break off in to separate groups as they challenge their opponents while being judged on their movements and gestures.

**PUPPET THEATER** *For ages PreK - 5 yrs*

It's imagination time as kids are entertained with this art form of storytelling that brings their favorite folk tales to life, after which they will create their own puppets to take home to use in their very own show.



**Patchwork Earth** *For ages 6 yrs - 6th grade*

Under the instruction of artist Michelle Olson, kids will design a section of a collaborative "Patchwork Earth", decorating their piece using a variety of multi-medium materials, representing their unique perspective on what makes the world colorful- such as family, traditions, nature, places, feelings, or friendships. Once complete, all the pieces will be assembled into one large globe celebrating how our different experiences come together to create a vibrant world.
